2. What two choices does Jesus present in this passage? What results come from these choices?
3. Why might a person build a house on sand in the first place? In what ways is such thinking short-sighted?
4. Who or what is the "rock" in this parable? What is meant by building a house on this "rock"?
5. What are some reasons for the importance of building our house on the rock? (verse 25)
6. Why is it that some people never think of examining their foundation until their house has "crashed"?
7. How do these verses provide a fitting conclusion to the Sermon on the Mount?
8. Read The Sermon on the Mount Together (Matthew 5-7)...*Note: Everyone please bring your Bible to your group for this meeting.*
9. What are some of the "words" of Jesus you have heard in the Sermon on the Mount (v. 24) that have stuck with you, changed you, challenged you, encouraged you, etc? What will you take with you as this series comes to an end?
