Connect & Review

1. As you learn to pray in the way Jesus did (freshly surrender, consciously depend, and humbly listen to the LORD), how are you “seeing” God work around you?

Investigate & Dig

2. Read John 4:1-42. Which verse jumps out at you, and why?
3. As you listened to the message, what stood out to you?

Apply & Respond

4. Habit #2 is Compassionate Curiosity. Are you more of a talker or listener with others? What are you learning about compassionately listening and asking people questions?
5. Have you ever had a conversation with someone you felt was a “divine” appointment? What happened, and how did you see God working?
6. How does listening vertically to the LORD (Habit #1) help you to practice listening better horizontally (Habit #2) with the people you meet? Share an example.
7. What “wells” (places) in your weekly routine does Jesus want you to open your eyes?
8. Encourage everyone this week to ask at least one question of genuine interest with people they meet. Be prepared to begin next week’s gathering by sharing, “As you practiced compassionate curiosity this week, what did you notice or see happen?”
9. Close by praying as a group for each other.
