The Holy Spirit

Who is He? How does He work? Here are just some of the Bible's answers.

The Holy Spirit is a person, not an "it." He speaks (Acts 13:2; Revelation 2:7). He intercedes & prays (Romans 8:26). He testifies & brings glory to Jesus (John 15:26; 16:14-15). He leads (Acts 8:29, Romans 8:14). He commands (Acts 16:6-7). He quides (John 16:7-13). He appoints (Acts 20:28). He encourages believers (Acts 9:31). He fills believers (Acts 4:8, 31; Ephesians 5:18). He brings unity & God's love among believers (Romans 5:5; Ephesians 4:1). He can be lied to (Acts 5:3-4). He can be blasphemed (Matthew 12:31-32). He can be resisted (Acts 7:51). He can be grieved (Ephesians 4:30). He can be insulted (Hebrews 10:29). He can be guenched (1 Thessalonians 5:19).

<u>The Holy Spirit is co-equal with God and is God</u> (Matthew 28:19). He is *eternal* (Hebrews 9:14). He is *involved in Creation* (Genesis 1:2; cf. 1:26—God is plural "us"). He is *everywhere present* (Psalm 139:7). He is *all-knowing* (1 Corinthians 2:10-11). He is the *author of the Bible* (Acts 1:16, 2 Peter 1:20-21). He is *called God & the Lord* (Acts 5:3-4; 2 Corinthians 3:18). He is the *3rd person of the Trinity or Godhead* (2 Corinthians 13:14).

The Holy Spirit was deeply involved in Jesus' earthly ministry. Jesus' conception as a human being was by the Holy Spirit (Luke 1 :35). Jesus' baptism was visited by the Holy Spirit (Luke 3:21-22). Jesus 'ministry was accredited by the Holy Spirit (John 1 :32-33). Jesus was led by the Holy Spirit (Luke 4:1). Jesus was anointed by the Holy Spirit (Luke 4:18). Jesus was empowered by the Holy Spirit (Matthew 12:22-28). Jesus offered Himself as an atonement for sin by the Holy Spirit (Hebrews 9:14). Jesus was raised to life by the Holy Spirit (Romans 8: 11). Jesus promised, with His Father, to send the Holy Spirit (John 14:26). Jesus came to baptize people with the Holy Spirit (Mark 1:8). Jesus said we must be born again of the Holy Spirit (John 3:3-8).
