
His Story – Our Story

- 7. Read Jeremiah 29:10-14. What good news did God have for them?
- 8. If God's overarching plan is to have a <u>people</u> who shine His light in this world, how can you practice going through hard times together as a group?
- 9. After listening to the message, what's the Lord want you to know? Do?
