## JESUS FULFILLING PSALM 22

- Psalm 22 begins in \_\_\_\_\_ (vss 1-20), ends in \_\_\_\_\_ (vss 21-31).
- *Forsaken* = abandoned, \_\_\_\_\_, turned \_\_\_\_\_ or deserted.

- ② Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_. As execution, judgment & \_\_\_\_\_ fall on Him.
- ③ Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_. As He \_\_\_\_\_ infinitely & \_\_\_\_\_. Heb 2:9-18; 5:7-8
- ④ Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_. \_\_\_\_\_ righteousness for \_\_\_\_\_ unrighteousness. 2 Cor 5:21
- Nations & future generations will \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_. Ps 22:22; Heb 2:12
