## Connect & Review

1. As you practiced a “sent” mindset last week, how did it go? How can you continue?
2. Share about your baptism. What do you remember?

## Investigate & Dig

3. Read **Mark 1:9-13** about Jesus’ baptism & testing. What stood out to you in these verses or in the message, and why? *Often what stands out to us is God speaking to us.*

## Apply & Respond

4. In Jesus’ baptism, we see a beautiful picture of the Trinity—one God in three persons. How does the fellowship (the dance) of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit speak to you?
5. How do the Father, Son & Holy Spirit mutually “glorify” each other at Jesus’ baptism? When or where do you find yourself wanting to “glorify” God these days?
6. In Jesus’ testing, how did Satan lie and tempt Jesus (see Matthew 4:1-11)? When & how are you tempted to orient your life around what you get out of it? Share an example.
7. How can your baptism in the name (the dance) of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit (see Matthew 28:19) shape the way you give yourself this week to God and others?
8. Assured by Jesus’ finished work and God’s self-giving love for you, what do you need to tell yourself if you begin to live selfishly in some way?
9. Close by praying for each other, that God will teach us how to dance with Him as we practice life together.
