- 1. As you practiced a "sent" mindset last week, how did it go? How can you continue?
- 2. Share about your baptism. What do you remember?

Investigate & Dig

3. Read Mark 1:9-13 about Jesus' baptism & testing. What stood out to you in these verses or in the message, and why? Often what stands out to us is God speaking to us.

Apply & Respond

- 4. In Jesus' baptism, we see a beautiful picture of the Trinity—one God in three persons. How does the fellowship (the dance) of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit speak to you?
- 5. How do the Father, Son & Holy Spirit mutually "glorify" each other at Jesus' baptism? When or where do you find yourself wanting to "glorify" God these days?
- 6. In Jesus' testing, how did Satan lie and tempt Jesus (see Matthew 4:1-11)? When & how are you tempted to orient your life around what you get out of it? Share an example.
- 7. How can your baptism in the name (the dance) of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit (see Matthew 28:19) shape the way you give yourself this week to God and others?
- 8. Assured by Jesus' finished work and God's self-giving love for you, what do you need to tell yourself if you begin to live selfishly in some way?
- 9. Close by praying for each other, that God will teach us how to dance with Him as we practice life together.
