Connect & Review

1. If money were no object, to whom or to what cause would you be generous, and how?
2. In a few words, describe how your family handled money when you were growing up.

Investigate & Dig

3. Read **2 Corinthians 8:1-5**. What do you notice in these verses and what stood out in the message? What's God saying to you? *Often what stands out to us is God speaking to us.*

Apply & Respond

4. In the first two messages in this series, the same counsel of "*Name reality, form a plan & take action*" has been given. Of the three, which one is most difficult for you, and why?
5. If you took time to fill out the budget worksheet, share what you learned or noticed.
6. If the 10-10-80 plan is simply a starter plan you can adjust, what questions does this suggested plan raise for you? How might you vary the percentages in different seasons?
7. Where do you see our church family practicing generosity? Where can we do better?
8. What's one way you want to get better in the way you steward God's money?
9. Close by praying for each other, that God will grow our character and heart size, as He teaches us how to live generously as a church family.
